Camp Information

Snow Bowl Camp (formerly Summer Rec and Camp-A-Homa)

Get ready for some guaranteed fun this summer at Snow Bowl Camp, presented by the Penobscot Bay YMCA. In addition to relocating to the Snow Bowl, Camp-A-Homa is combining with Summer Rec to serve kids 7-10 years old at a new "Snow Bowl Camp." Campers will experience traditional camp fun and excitement, with a cool new twist each week.

WHAT IT'S ALL ABOUT:

- Snow Bowl Camp is Monday-Friday for kids ages 7-10 (by 7/1/19).
- Home base is the Camden Snow Bowl
- Before and After Care are available for this camp at the Snow Bowl for an additional fee. Before Care is from 7-8:30 a.m.; After Care is from 4-5:30 p.m.
- Camp begins at 8:30 a.m. Parents who do not participate in Before Care may drop campers off between 8:30 and 8:45 a.m. All campers must be checked in individually by camp staff.
- Campers may be picked up at the Snow Bowl between 3:45 and 4 p.m. Campers in need of After Care will stay at the Snow Bowl.
- Each week consists of swimming, field games, arts & crafts, nature hikes, STEM projects, mountain biking, paddle boarding, canoeing and more.
- On Mondays, campers will spend part of their morning at the Y taking swim tests.
- Tuesdays will be spent at local beaches and parks.
- Each Wednesday, we will take exciting field trips to destinations all over the State of Maine.

Adventure Camp

Adventure Camp is for pre-teens and teens who love spending time with their friends and are looking for some adventure this summer. This camp will give campers a new and exciting experience beyond our traditional camp programs. Every day, campers will explore the outdoors through hiking, boating, swimming, fishing, climbing and group challenges.

WHAT IT'S ALL ABOUT:

- Snow Bowl Camp is a Monday-Friday for kids ages 11-13 (by 7/1/19).
- Home base is the Camden Snow Bowl; camp runs from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Before and After Care are available for this camp at the Snow Bowl for an additional fee. Before Care is from 7-8:30 a.m. Campers are welcome to stay with the program until camp begins at 9 a.m.
- Parents who do not participate in Before Care may drop campers off between 9 and 9:15 a.m. All campers must be checked in individually by camp staff.
- Bus transportation to the Snow Bowl is available. Campers will be picked up each morning at the Teen Center by 8:45 a.m.
- Campers may be picked up at the Snow Bowl between 3 and 3:15 p.m.
- Campers in need of After Care will be bused to the Teen Center between 2:45 and 3 p.m. The Teen Center is a free program for kids in grades 5-12, and is open during the summer, Monday-Friday, 12:30-5 p.m.
- Each week consists of outdoor exploration, team building, climbing, fishing, hiking, swimming and ecological education.
- Each Wednesday, we will take long field trips to destinations all over the State of Maine.
